This recording features new music of South America performed by flutist Jessica Warren-Acosta and the Avalon String Quartet. Works include Ginastera's *Impresiones de la Puna*, *Sonatina Fantasia* and *Amanaecer* by Andres Sas, *Cuatro Bosquejos Pre-Incaicos* by Gabriela Lena Frank, Diego Luzuriaga's *Yaravi & Yumbo* and *Tierra... Tierra...*, Osvaldo Golijov's *Lullaby and Doina*, Liduino Pitombeira's *The Hollow Earth*, Jose Carlos Campos' *Alone*, and *Melodia Sentimental* by Heitor Villa-Lobos. Seven of the nine works are world premiere recordings. Some of these works are very interesting, most of them are short, and several would be nice additions to recital programs. The Villa-Lobos in particular is a wonderful piece of music. Warren-Acosta has a beautiful sound and plays extremely well. (FILA 0103)
